Albert's connection is a unique collaborative project with the students of Coburg University in Germany to produce a temporary spatial intervention for Creapolis on the Campus Design Open - Festival (parallel to the Coburger Design Tage). Coburg and Manchester have historical connections with Prince Albert, both cities featuring a monument to Albert in their main squares, the history of which will become a starting point for design proposals. Prince Albert was born in Coburg and its his 200th birthday this year. You will travel to Coburg for the events period to collaborate with students from the city.

ROLE

You will travel to Coburg and set up into design teams of 4, 2 Manchester Students + 2 Coburg students. You will research the history of the two cities and Prince Albert's relationship to them. You will analyse the site and develop a concept for the area around the Schlachthof (Slaughterhouse). You will develop your designs in detail and present them to the jury. The proposals will then be built for Creapolis on the Campus Design Open - Festival at the end of May.
