STUDENTS WILL THEN CREATE NEW PIECES OF BESPOKE FURNITURE USING THE PIECES THEY RECIEVE. THE FURNITURE WILL THEN BE PLACED IN THEIR NEW OFFICE FOYER TO BE SOLD.

AT THE END OF THE TWO WEEKS WE WILL BE HOLDING AN EVENT AT MUSTARD TREE'S MAIN OFFICE WHERE THE BESPOKE CREATIONS WILL BE CRITIQUED.



STUDENTS WILL PRODUCE THE FURNITURE WITHIN THE UNIVERSITY WORKSHOPS AND BECOME ACCUSTOMED WITH TECHNIQUES AND EXPERIENCE. THE ZINE WILL BE PRODUCED ON INDESIGN, WHICH WILL BE TAUGHT BY US IN A SEPARATE SESSION. UPON COMPLETION OF THE FURNITURE, WE WILL HELP STUDENTS TO TAKE WELL- CONSIDERED PHOTOGRAPHS TO SUPPORT THE ZINE. WE HOPE TO PROVIDE STUDENTS WITH TRANSFERRABLE SKILLS TO HELP WITH THEIR PORTFOLIOS AND FUTURE STUDIES.
