We are seeking students who are enthusiastic about adaptive reuse, visual communication, and social engagement.

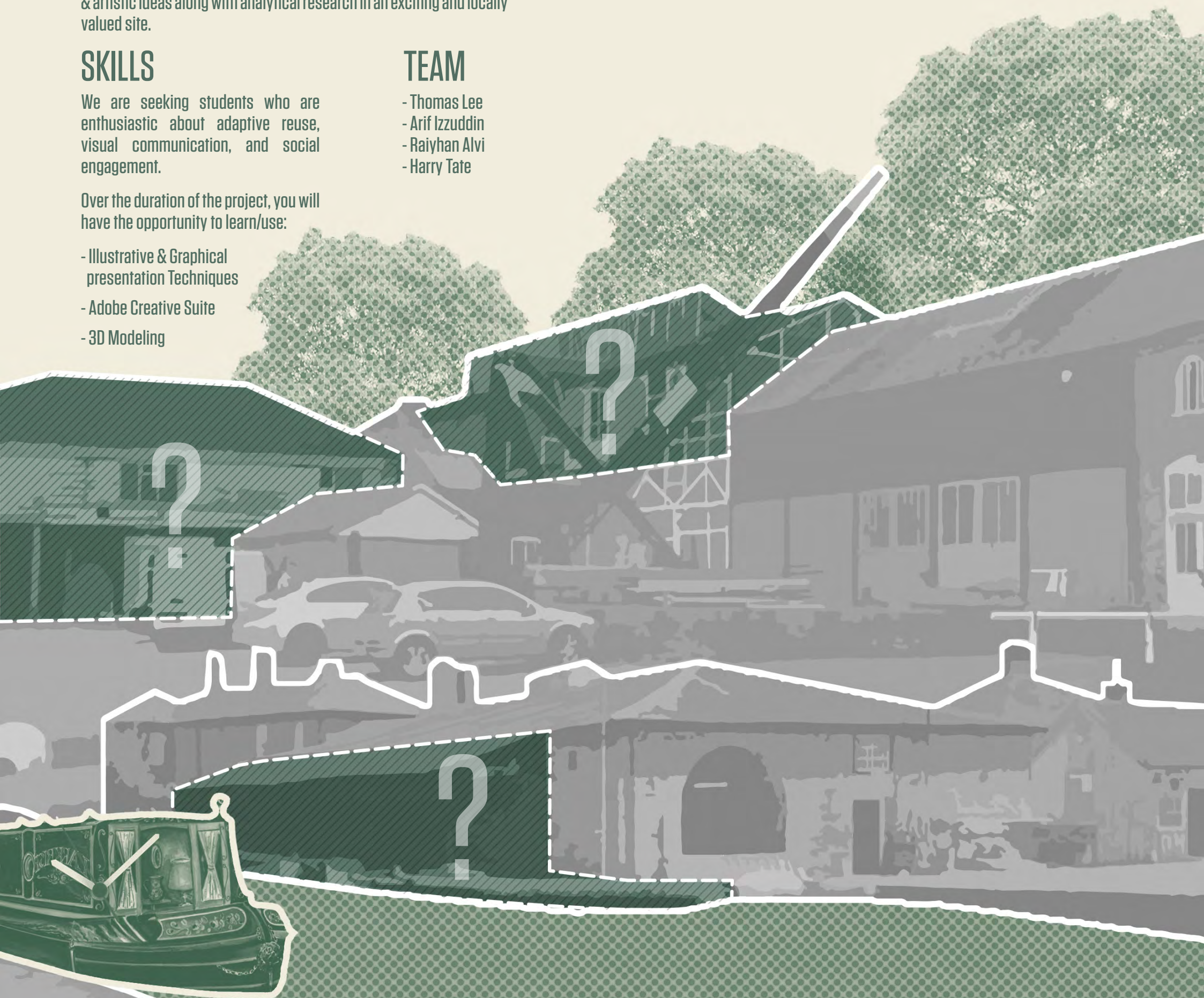
